

Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. Which of the projects will you do first or will you do them at the same time? We will begin with the new room because there is also some maintenance required on the exterior of the building (building envelope). Last year, we became aware of this urgency of this exterior repair and this work would be most cost efficient if it was done in coordination with the new room we hope to build. We hope to do the kitchen when it is not being heavily used by the ministries of the church.
- 2. What is your **timeline** for beginning construction? The eldership has made a decision not to begin the projects until the majority of the budget has been donated or pledged. However, our hope is to begin building the new room in the late spring and renovate the kitchen during the late July.
- 3. How much **money do we need to have in hand** over what has been pledged in order to start? The exact percentage of this has not been determined but the majority of the funds do need to be pledged.
- 4. If I make a **pledge** does it have for the full 2-year period? No, it is the donor's choice as to how many months their pledge will be for.
- 5. I'm a **tradesperson**. Can I donate my time and skills? We are hiring a contractor, architect and engineers who will coordinate the project. From time to time, we may be looking for people to help with demolition and site clean up but the vast majority of work will be done through the general contractor. However, if you are a tradesperson, we can contact you with the general contractor once they are chosen.
