I Believe

The Apostles' Creed opens with a powerful assertion: "I Believe." It's an assertion repeated two more times before the creed is done. But what does it mean to believe?

Discuss

What does this song make you think about the statement: "I Believe"?

What does "I Believe" Mean?

When Christians confess, "I believe..." there are four things being asserted:

- 1) *Faith means assent* Faith is believing that certain things are true.
- 2) **Faith means trust** Faith is saying, "yes" to God. It's a decision, an act of will to trust God. To say "I believe" is to trust that God is actually who he says he is. It is to trust that he will actually do what he says he will do.

Discuss: What areas of your life do you think God wants to heal, restore or redeem? What might it look like to believe that he actually will do this?

- 3) *Faith means commitment* "I believe is a public declaration of one's commitment God. To believe in God is to belong to God.
- 4) *Faith means obedience* Faith leads us to obedience. It is a willingness to trust and obey the God who has called us to faith in him.

When Christian's say, "I believe in God" they are not merely making a cerebral assertion. They are proclaiming a commitment to lean into God, to encounter the real person that is God. They are committing to being shaped and changed by the person they meet.

Discuss

If Christian belief includes action, what does that look like in the lives of Jesus followers?

Recite Creed and Pray

Close your time together reciting the Creed and praying that God would give us real faith. Faith that involves the head, heart, hands and feet!
