Quick Trip Facts:

August 10-23, 2023. \$4000 CDN/person. Team of 10-13 adults. Focus on soccer, fence-building, and discipling youth.

Vision & Team Makeup: We are looking for 10-13 people ages 18+ who are regular attenders of NSAC to form this Team. This Trip would be particularly beneficial for people with skills and experience in construction, soccer playing or coaching, discipling youth, and/or those sensing a call from God to missions.

Background & Overview: For the past seven years, NSAC has partnered with missionaries Kim & Brenden Vowell. The Vowells head up Project Samuel a few hours from Lusaka, Zambia, Africa, where they provide care, discipleship, lifeskills, and a home for more than 20 Zambian children and youth. To grow the "mission hearts" of our people, NSAC Outreach Pastor, Dave Sattler is leading a Missions Team to support the Vowells in their ministry in three primary ways: 1) To fund and provide labour for a \$30,000 fence construction project on the Project Samuel site (fencing is vital for agriculture to make the project selfsustainable), 2) to run a soccer camp and tournament, and 3) to spend time discipling the Project Samuel youth.

Costs: \$4000 CDN/person payable to NSAC. Trip fees are tax-receiptible and due in instalments: \$1000 due April 1/2023, \$1500 due June 1/2023, and \$1500 due July 1/2023 (includes all airfares and visas, and 10 days' in-country accommodation, transportation, meals, and one-day safari). Travel medical insurance, immunizations (also tax-receiptible with receipts submitted to NSAC), & trip spending money is extra. Some financial assistance is available upon request. Construction Project costs will be fundraised by the Team.
